## What was life like for Bernard?

- Try on a gas mask
- Play some popular games from the time
- Test your memory to see if you could be a spy
- Learn Morse Code and tap a message
- Collect your ration and plan a meal
- Feel some real clothes from the time of 'make do and mend'
- Discover the difference ball-bearings make in machinery and why Hoffmann's factory was a target

Children have a go in groups (4), moving round the room with a bell.
